

# HOW TO MEASURE

## YOU WILL NEED:

### ▶ TAPE MEASURE

With metric units (cm and mm)

### ▶ A SKORT/SKIRT YOU OWN

A garment you own, from any brand, with a comfortable fit.

All measurement(s) need to be taken from a garment you own.

#### 1 Find a skort/skirt you own:

Choose a skort/skirt you currently own (any brand) which is the most comfortable fit for you.

#### 2 Relaxed waist measurement:

Lay the skort/skirt down on a flat surface and measure the distance across the waist band while the elastic is relaxed as shown in point A.

#### 3 Hip measurement

Lay the skort/skirt down on a flat surface. Measure the distance across the skort/skirt at the hips (this is 20cm down from the waist) as shown in point B.

#### 4 Front length

Lay the skort/skirt down on a flat surface. Measure the distance across the skort/skirt from top to bottom as shown in point C.

Waist (relaxed)	27	29	31	33	35	37	39	41	43
Hips (20cm down from waist)	36	38	40	42	44	46	48	50	52
Front length	31	32	33	34	35	36	38	39	40

\* Please allow for a plus or minus 1-2 cm tolerance in our garments. Material is also a factor in how a garment can fit you. We will have more details in the product description regarding the material stretch. If the material is stretchy then you can wear the garment as a tighter fit as the material will stretch. Please be aware that the above measurements are of the garment and not of your body.
